Big Tree Contest: American Beech



"American Beech, easily recognized from a distance by its smooth, steel-gray bark and tapering surface roots at the base of its trunk, is present throughout all of Ohio. This tree is a favorite of children and teenagers who love to carve their initials onto its large smooth trunks. Many beech trees are partially hollow and provide excellent den sites for various wildlife. Its small, triangular nuts are relished by both mammals and birds in autumn." — ODNR Division of Forestry.


Who has the tallest corn in the county?




Watershed Kayak Tour
